USDOT Number Operating History.

Bristol West uses operating history collected by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) in determining the most accurate rates for commercial auto customers with a USDOT number. If the business has a vehicle with a USDOT number, enter the USDOT number on the general screen. If USDOT information is not found, verify the number in the SAFER system (<http://safer.fmcsa.dot.gov>) using the business name.
